

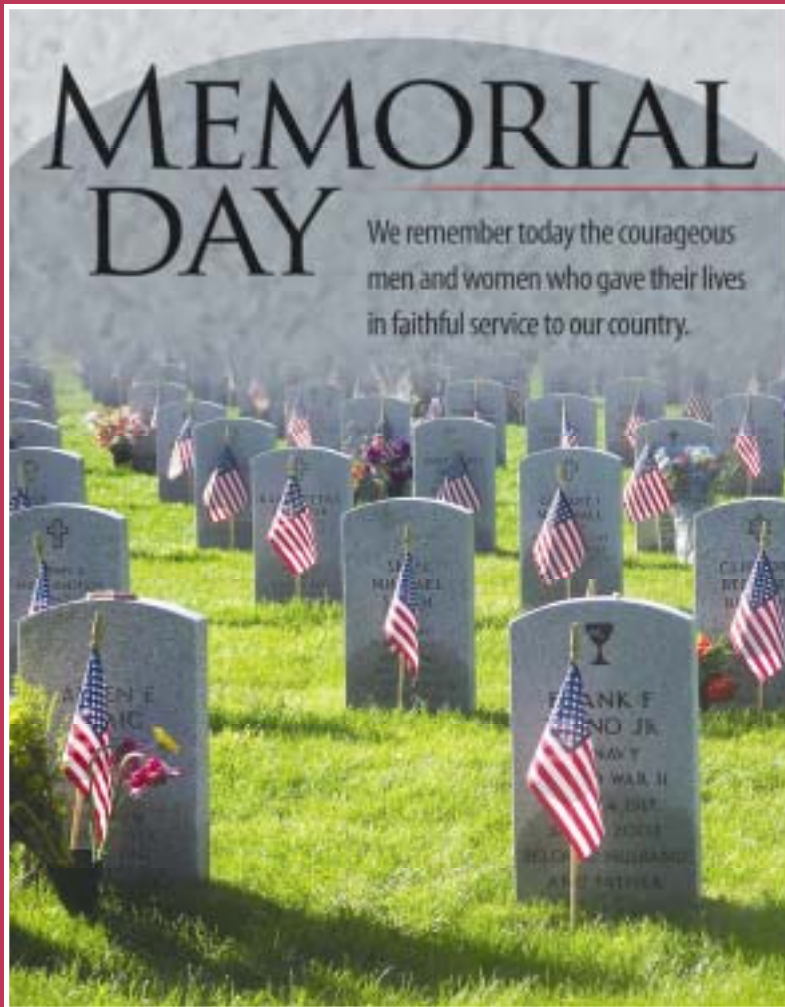

Let us never forget to pray, not only for the dead, but also for those still living and working in the cause of freedom around the world.

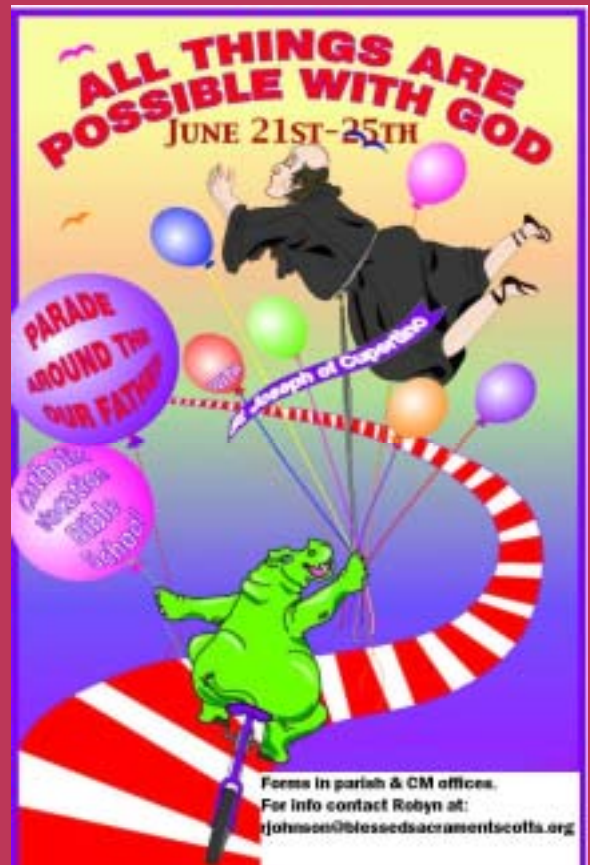
As we celebrate and enjoy this time, give comfort and grace to those men and women who have sacrificed so much for our sake.

## Pastor's Corner...

Faith is the grace of a mysterious encounter with Someone. It is beyond reasoning and emotion, but these may be present also. We can grasp God with our minds and with our senses, in fact, with our whole being. We are talking not just about an intellectual conviction about God, but a sense of God, a feeling. Happy are those who have a sense of God and of His presence in their lives. It is the only riches worth having. As one person once said, "Lord, I don't need to believe in you. It's not a matter of belief any more. I just know."

When people know something, really know deep down in their hearts, they don't have to argue about it, or prove it. They just know it, and that's enough. Faith is truly a gift of God. One believes with the heart, without knowing why or even seeking to know.

It is a great blessing to experience God's presence in the world, but it is a still greater blessing to experience God's presence within us. We meet God not just in the world outside us, but in the world within us, and find that He is closer to us than we can imagine. He is part of us. In the words of St. Paul, "In Him we live and move and have our being." (Acts 17:28)

God is everywhere present yet nowhere visible. He is like a biographer whose job is to tell the story while staying in the background.

For many the silence of God is a big problem. But "a loud and evident God would be a bully, an insecure tyrant, instead of, as He is, a bottomless encouragement to our faltering and frightened being. His answers come in the long run, as the large facts in our lives, strung on that thread running through all things." (John Updike)

Some people want to know everything, to explain everything, break everything down into facts. But it is exciting

to live with mystery. Albert Einstein said, "The most beautiful experience we can have is that of the mysterious." Even with faith, the mystery, the darkness, the unknowable remain. The whole of life is not visible to us. As Van Gogh said, "Here on earth we see only one hemisphere."

God is the only one to whom we can surrender without losing ourselves.

Last Saturday we celebrated our Appreciation Dinner. It is a "Thank You" celebration to all those who serve the parish and community in the various ministries and volunteer positions. Your generosity gives support, comfort, spiritual peace, direction, aid, etc. to so many people. I also want to once again publicly thank our parish staff who give and give and give to serve this community. We are so blessed to have such gifted, talented and generous servants who do their best and use their God-given gifts to support their pastor and parish. Thank you to everyone who makes Blessed Sacrament the wonderful community it is.

As we gather this weekend to celebrate Eucharist, which means 'Thanksgiving,' we also remember and give thanks to all who have served our country, defended our freedoms, and make it possible for us to gather in prayer and worship. We say thank you to all who have given their lives, the wounded in body, mind and spirit, and all who continue to serve. May God watch over them and bring them home safely. ## Liturgy Corner..

God's incredible love is totally incomprehensible. We can try to imagine it, and we can compare it to the love we experience as human beings, but the reality is that God's love is so overwhelming and unconditional, that it will never be possible for us to comprehend how great God's love is. That's why the feast we celebrate today, the Most Holy Trinity, can leave us with more questions than answers. In truth, any theologian who has tried to plumb the mystery of the Trinity, whether saints like Thomas Aquinas or Augustine, or contemporary scholars like Karl Rahner or Gerald O'Collins, may write page after page, but in the end is still left standing before the mystery.

One of the most famous images of the Trinity, the icon by the Russian master Andrei Rublev (ca. 1360-1430), is an image of hospitality. The three persons of the Trinity are represented by angelic beings seated around a four-sided table inviting the viewer to come and take a place to dine with them. When we encounter the love of God and truly experience it, this is in effect what happens to us: we are seated at the table and enveloped in God's love.

In the icon, the place at the table is empty, because it is there for anyone and everyone. It is not just my place or yours. Everything that the Father has, is also of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. And so it is with the place at the table. When God invites us in, it is not to the exclusion of others, but to the welcome of all. We may question how this is even possible, since as limited creatures we parcel out our time, our resources, and even our love. God does no such thing. And the more we are caught up in God's love, the more we are able to express that love to others.

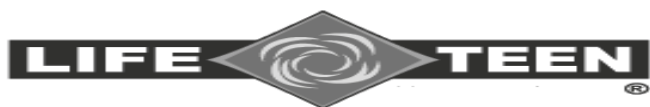
Our open heart begins with **Hospitality**, to one another and to ourselves.
