### *The Caring Place...*

#### **Duet Volunteer Support Opportunities**

Each month *The Caring Place* Ministry Advisory Board, a joint partnership between our parish, St. Joan of Arc, and St. Patrick's parishes, meet to discuss and plan educational and volunteer activities that offer physical, emotional and spiritual support to all seniors, adults with disabilities and their caregivers.

At a recent meeting, the group met with Nancy Splain, Outreach Coordinator for *Duet* Partners in Health & Aging (formerly known as Beatitudes/DOAR). Nancy provided an overview of the *Duet* volunteer support services provided to homebound elders and adults with disabilities - to help them live independently in their own homes. The services include: grocery shopping, transportation to medical appointments, friendly visiting and phoning, paperwork assistance, handyman services, limited respite assistance, computer assistance and home safety assessments. Services are available in Phoenix, Fountain Hills, Glendale, Litchfield Park, Paradise Valley, Peoria, & Scottsdale.

*Duet* is a training resource for faith communities and nurses who want to create and sustain health programs that promote health, healing and disease prevention in a faith-community setting. Parishioner, Marianne Ast, is leading the efforts to initiate our parish's faith-community nurse program. *Duet* provides caregiver support group service, as well as, support for grandparents raising grandchildren. If you are in need of any of these services - call Nancy, and she will assist you by allocating a trained parishioner and covered on *Duet's* liability insurance, to serve your need. ## Pastor's Corner...

In our Gospel reading this weekend we have the story of Jesus feeding the five thousand. The apostles approached Jesus and asked Him to dismiss the crowd so that they might find food to eat. Jesus' response was, "Give them some food yourselves." They replied that all they had were five loaves and two fish. Jesus took what they had, gave thanks to God, blessed the food and gave the food to the disciples to set before the crowd. They all ate and were satisfied.

This story is more than just another miracle. It is more than Jesus feeding five thousand. Jesus is showing us His strong desire to remain with us, even after He died, rose and ascended to heaven.

Jesus remains with us not only in the Scriptures we read, not only in the living Church, not only in the examples of the saints, but even in the humble and silent appearance of bread and wine. In the Eucharist, He is as close to us as He was to those people who walked with Him on the dusty roads of Palestine. In fact, He is even closer. Those people received bread from His hands, but we receive the Lord Himself in Holy Communion. What more could Jesus have done to show us how passionately He wants to be near us, to guide us, to strengthen us.

Jesus has not changed since the day He fed the five thousand. He has not all of a sudden become selfish, harsh and unforgiving. He is as good and generous now as He was then.

As was mentioned last week, we have access to three Catholic Grade Schools in our area – Blessed Pope John XXIII Catholic School, Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic School and St Theresa's Catholic School. Blessed Pope John XXIII School is just to the north of us. OLPH and St Theresa's have school buses that pick up and drop off our students in our parking lot each school day. All three are excellent schools and I encourage you to check them out. Laying a good faith foundation for our young people is all our responsibility. Check the brochure racks in our church lobbies for brochures and additional information about the schools in our area. We are indeed blessed to have these resources available to our community.



On June 5<sup>th</sup>, Bishop Olmsted ordained three men to the Priesthood for service in the Diocese of Phoenix. It was a great day for them and for all of us. Our seminaries are filling with men who want to serve the Lord and His people. Continue praying for vocations to the Priesthood, Religious Life (Sisters, Priests and Brothers) and Diaconate. It is a big Church and we need Shepherds to lead.

Have a great week everyone. Summer is here. Enjoy time with family and friends and invite Jesus to be a part of the fun!

## Liturgy Corner..

On holidays, the table at grandma's house was always full-a full complement of aunts, uncles, and cousins, and a full array of food. With two stoves (one in the kitchen and one in the basement) and two refrigerators (in the same locations) it was a sure bet that we were not going to run out of food even with the extended family gathered around. And afterward, when everyone was ready leave, there were plenty of leftovers to be packed up and sent home for enjoyment in the coming days.

Like grandma's holiday feasts, the miracle of the loaves and fishes left everyone satisfied. There were even leftovers that got packed up into twelve wicker baskets as St. Luke tells us. But Luke's account of the event contains more than just a great story about a lot of food. If that were all there was to the story, the miracle of the loaves and fishes wouldn't be that different from the abundance of food at grandma's holiday table. Luke's story, like every description of this miracle in the four Gospels, contains ritual language that points to what Jesus did with bread and wine before He died: He took, blessed, broke, and gave.

When we gather on Sunday to celebrate the Eucharist, we do exactly the same things in a ritual manner through the taking of the bread and wine at the procession with the gifts, the blessing in the Eucharistic prayer, the breaking of the bread at the Lamb of God, and the giving in Communion. The miracle of God's abundant blessing is made present not through a lot of bread and fish, but through the gift of His Son and our communion with Him. It is an abundant feast, and the leftovers we take home is our commission to love and serve each day.

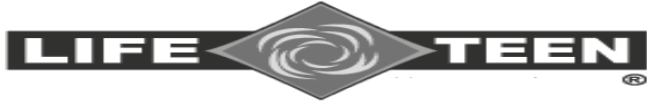

Bishop Olmsted has issued a new marriage preparation policy for the diocese of Phoenix that began implementation on January 1, 2010. There will now be at least a **nine month** preparation process prior to the wedding. This extra time is to allow for a more thorough preparation for the sacrament, including the full course in Natural Family Planning ([www.phxnfp.org](http://www.phxnfp.org)) and a new session on "God's Plan for a Joy-Filled marriage" ([www.ourcovenantoflovephx.org](http://www.ourcovenantoflovephx.org)).
