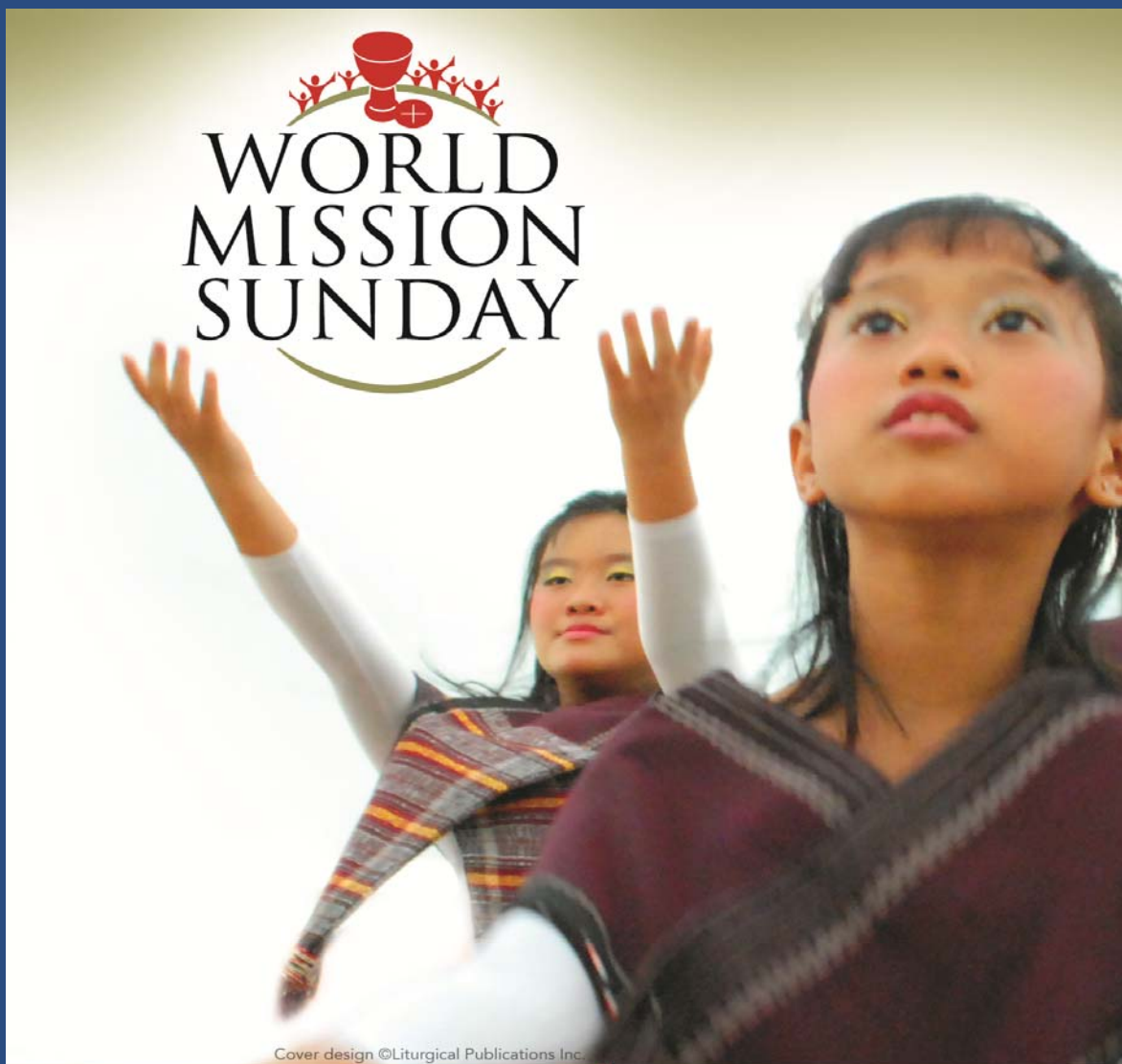

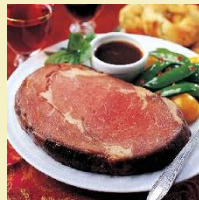
*PLEASE ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES FOR THE CHILDREN WHO DRESS AS SAINTS AND ATTEND MASS:*

- We ask that an attitude of respect and sacredness of the liturgy be retained.



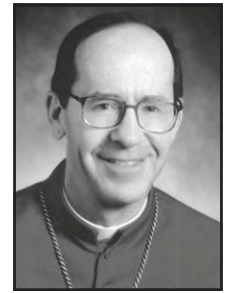

## Pastor's Corner - A Message from the Bishop...



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Lord, before returning to the Father, promised His followers the Holy Spirit and charged them with being His “witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth (Acts 1:9).

At Baptism, we too were called to be Christ’s witnesses. We are to share our faith with those around us, and to support, in prayer and sacrifice, the work of missionaries who bring the “Good News” of Jesus to faraway places - to Africa, Asia, the Pacific Islands, and remote regions of Latin America.

## Liturgy Corner..

Self-esteem and self-promotion are generally credited as values. Psychologists and social workers often attribute difficulties in social adjustment, problems with bullying, addiction to drugs or alcohol, increased rates of teenage pregnancy and domestic abuse to low self-esteem. In the jobless culture of these difficult economic times low self-esteem can eat away at one's psychological health. As a counteractive measure, many counselors encourage the unemployed to engage in self-promotion, advertising their desirable qualities to potential employers in the same way a product might be marketed to consumers.

The Pharisee in this week's Gospel certainly has no problem with self-promotion. He is well-qualified for a position on Madison Avenue, though he would probably be hawking himself more than the products he would be trying to market. Some might see the self-deprecating tax collector as one of the down-and-out folks who is never going to make it, because he just doesn't have the verve and initiative to get out there and sell himself. An out-placement counselor might advise him to project his good points-dedicated worker, good with numbers, financially savvy, willing to take on a hard job, etc.

All of those good points may indeed be a part of the tax collector's profile. But there are other aspects of his life as well that need some work, and he is ready to acknowledge that. This is what humility really is-being honest about oneself. Self-esteem and self-promotion still have their value in a humble person. Indeed, a truly humble person needs good self-esteem to be able to examine himself or herself critically to come to an honest appraisal of virtues and shortcomings. Real humility is not about making ourselves worthless, but about developing an assessment of our true worth and the improvements we still need to make with God's help.

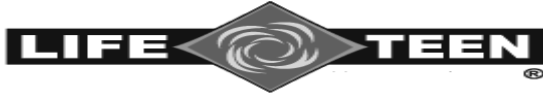

## THE JOURNEY TO COMMITMENT WEEKEND

### 2nd STOP—THE PILLAR OF PRAYER

*"Thy Will be Done."*

While the Pillar of Hospitality is first in our Stewardship model; Prayer is the most important Pillar.

Members of a four-pillar parish nourish their souls through prayer and with the Sacraments are disposed to receive God's abundant graces. It is through prayer that we nurture our personal relationship with Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Eucharist, as our central prayer, holds a deep connection with Stewardship.

In both our personal and communal prayer, we turn to God to discern our talents and gifts; to discern His Will. Using our Time, Talent, and Treasure is our response to the conversation with God that is Prayer.

**The following Gifts/Charisms Support Prayer.**  
Celibacy, Discernment of Gifts, Evangelism, Faith, Healing, Intercessory Prayer, Missionary, Pastoring, Prophecy, Voluntary Poverty.

**The following Ministries Focus on Prayer.**
