Service, by those of all ages, provides the opportunity to practice hospitality, prayer, and formation.

## The Four Pillars and Your Gifts

In thanksgiving for the gifts God has given us, we are called to return a portion of our gifts to Him. This is an offering of our “first fruits,” a contribution by which we express God’s priority in our lives and by which we distinguish between needs and wants. In a Four Pillar lifestyle this is accomplished through our Time, Talent, and Treasure. Please check off the ministries you already work with or in which you might have an interest.

When considering the “Treasure” aspect of giving, each household is asked to work towards giving 5% or more of their income to the parish. If you are unable to commit the full 5% at this time, try to increase your current level by 1 or 2 percent.
