**Sacraments and Liturgy**

*The liturgy and sacraments provide the basis for the religious life of the Catholic Christian. Join us for a series of faith enriching evenings that will explore both the understanding and practice of the sacraments and liturgy within the Catholic Tradition.*

<p><b>September 19, 2011</b>  <b>Liturgy: The Work of the People</b>  <i>In this session we will explore together the Catholic understanding of Liturgy and Worship. Participants will walk away with a sense of the recent history of the liturgy as well as an understanding of how the liturgy applies to their lives.</i></p>	<p><b>February 27, 2012</b>  <b>The Sacraments of Initiation (Part 2)</b>  <i>The Second Vatican Council named the Eucharist as the summit and source of Christian life. In this session participants will examine and understand how the Eucharist is the fullness of Baptism and Confirmation and the ongoing source of Christian living.</i></p>
<p><b>October 17, 2011</b>  <b>Our Changing Liturgy</b>  <i>In this session we will look at the changes to the liturgy as they will be implemented at the beginning of Advent. Participants will walk away with an understanding that the liturgy is not changing – the words are... and that far from a turn backward, the changes actually move us forward.</i></p>	<p><b>March 26, 2012</b>  <b>The Sacraments of Healing</b>  <i>In this session we will deepen our understanding of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. Participants will walk away with the tools to explain why Catholics use the confessional and why Anointing of the Sick is no longer 'Last Rites'.</i></p>
<p><b>November 21, 2011</b>  <b>Sacraments – Why they're So Important</b>  <i>In this session we will explore the concept of sacraments and understand why the Catholic Church understands itself as 'Sacramental'. Participants will walk away with an understanding of themselves as sacramental people and will also understand how the sacraments reflect the action of God becoming human in Jesus Christ.</i></p>	<p><b>April 23, 2012</b>  <b>The Sacraments of Vocation</b>  <i>In this session, we will grow how we understand the vocations of Ordination and Marriage. Participants will walk away being able to name why these are sacraments and how these sacraments continue to serve and grow the Church.</i></p>
<p><b>January 23, 2012</b>  <b>The Sacraments of Initiation (Part 1)</b>  <i>In this session we will reflect on the meanings of the Sacraments of Initiation, Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. Participants will walk away with a deeper understanding of the relationship between baptism and confirmation.</i></p>
